Wine and Cheese Appreciation Workshop, 27 Apr 2023

HKIE Gas and Energy division held a Wine and Cheese Appreciation Workshop on 27 Apr 2023 at the VTC Wine and Beverage Laboratory. The workshop was attended by 17 participants who were interested in learning more about the brewing knowledge, as well as how to appreciate them professionally.

The workshop was led by VTC's professional educator, a certified sommelier and fromager, who has over 20 years of experience in the wine and cheese industry. He introduced the basic concepts of wine and cheese making, the principle grape varieties and cheese categories, and the factors that affect their quality and characteristics.

The participants had the opportunity to taste a curated selection of wines, such as Red, White, Rose, and Sparkling. The lesson guided the participants through the sensory evaluation of each wine and cheese, explaining their aroma, flavor, texture, and pairing suggestions. It was also shared some tips on how to store and serve wine and cheese properly.

The workshop was interactive and engaging, with participants asking questions and sharing their opinions throughout. The feedback from the participants was very positive, with many expressing their appreciation for tutor's knowledge and passion. They also said they enjoyed the variety and quality of the wines and cheeses provided, as well as the friendly and relaxed atmosphere of the workshop.
